- To facilitate human resource development and foster the national strategic plan on WFD
- To provide a general framework to be adapted, adopted in the region
- To provide a human health focused strategic framework to complement other relevant strategic frameworks
- The aim is developed for adoption, modification by interested regions and/or countries
- Support the implementation of GHSA and relevant and related multi-sectoral platforms and frameworks.

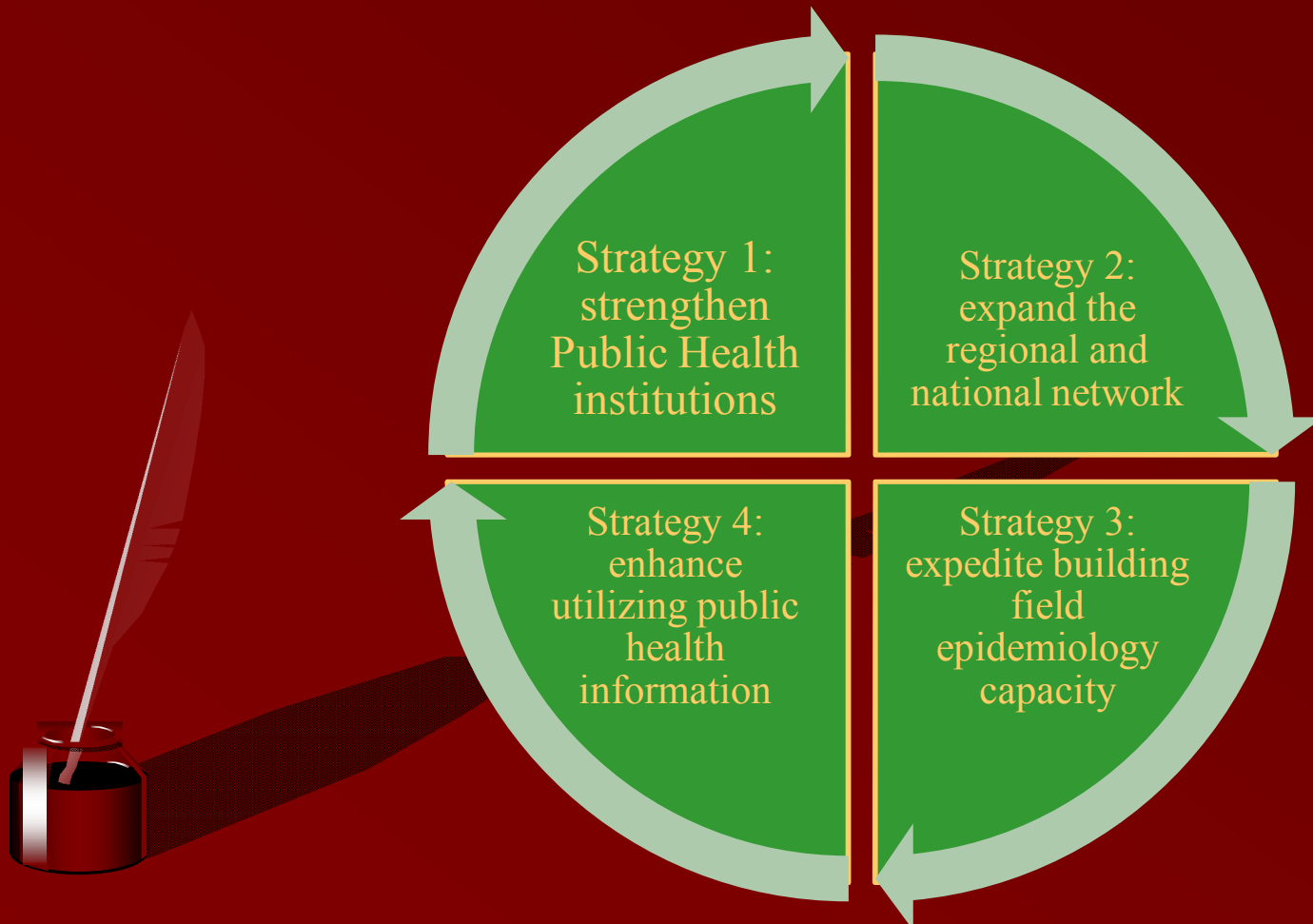
Regional Strategic Framework for Public Health Workforce Development and Systems Strengthening on Epidemiology

Vision: The countries have sufficient and competent workforce development and systems strengthening in epidemiology in order to effectively and sustainably prevent, detect and respond to public health threats in the region.

Target: one trained field epidemiologist (or equivalent) per 200,000 population, who can systematically cooperate to meet relevant IHR and PVS core competencies

Cross cutting strategy: multi-agency and multi-sectoral coordination and collaboration, One Health approach and coordination across GHSA Action Packages

GHSA 4-year workplan for D5 – WFD
